

Information regarding COVID-19 and Christmas Pines Campground:

At this point we plan to open for "self-contained RVs only" on May 1, 2020. We have delayed opening as the social distancing guidelines have been extended through the end of April.

That being said, being able to host guests is not a license for us to resume normal operations. We will keep you posted to the best of our abilities, in the meantime, stay healthy and stay home.

- The bathhouse, laundry room, playground, dog park, pavilion, pond area & store/snack bar area will be closed. Call the office, if you need something.
- Scheduled activities are cancelled/postponed until further notice.
- No tent camping or cabin rentals until further notice. Only self-contained RVs will be permitted.
- Dump station will remain open and Honey Wagon service will be operable. Call the office to schedule the Honey Wagon, if needed.
- Our seasonal families are to remain on their sites, only your immediate, "live at home family members", will be permitted. No social gatherings with other families will be allowed.
- No visitors during this time will be permitted in the campground.

****Please follow these guidelines, or you will be asked to go home and not permitted back until all these guidelines are lifted by the government.****

Campgrounds are currently considered, "life-sustaining" however this may change moving forward if we do not comply with the guidelines concerning the COVID-19 pandemic. The failure of campgrounds to enforce measures to mitigate the spread of the virus will result in campgrounds being closed indefinitely.

We understand this may change plans for some of you in light of these restrictions. If you feel you need to alter any upcoming reservations, we are asking that you kindly call the office.
